## **Memo**

Decision of the board meeting held on 19/09/2024 under agenda number 2 as appeared in the Minutes vide No. F. 1(1)/TBPE/Meeting/2024/609-15, dated 19/09/2024 are herewith communicated:

Extension of approval for D. Pharm. course with 60 intake capacity may be accorded for the session 2024-25; further-

1. BPT has not obtained 'No Objection' or permission from the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Tripura to increase the seat capacity for any course and to introduce any new course in the existing building by fulfilling necessary infrastructure, safety measures etc. and thus BPT may not be allowed to increase the seat capacity for any course and to introduce any new course without obtaining NOC. Otherwise, the extension of approval for D. Pharm. course may be cancelled automatically.
2. Deficiencies are needed to be fulfilled and compliance report has to be submitted within 31/12/2024.


Abstract and Deficiency recorded in case of Bharat Pharmaceutical Technology (BPT), Amtali, West Tripura; From the inspection report – 2024

1. Presently courses available: D. Pharm. with 60 intake capacity and B. Pharm. with 60 intake capacity
2. Own land is shown, but existing building is not situated in that land; rather building is utilized by college on lease at Amtali, Agartala – Bishalgarh Road, West Tripura.
3. Shortage in numbers and as well as small size is recorded in case of Class rooms, Laboratories.
4. No Aseptic room is available.
5. Adequate numbers of preparation rooms for laboratories are not available.
6. Small in size is recorded in case of Machine room, Central Instrument Room, Store rooms.
7. Shortage in numbers is recorded in case of HODs room.
8. Herbal Garden is not adequate.
9. No separate computer room is available, which is shown as Pharmacology Laboratory.
10. Mr. Priyatosh Sarkar is shown as faculty and workload is also mentioned, though he is on study leave.




11. Shortage of Faculties is recorded, particularly for D. Pharm. course.
12. Equipment and apparatus are found not adequate.
12. A meeting minutes of governing body of BPT dated 16/7/2023 approved a proposal of increasing intake of B. Pharm. from 60 to 100 and PG Program (M. Pharm.)(Minutes Point 3.3) and in addition, Principal of BPT has given a declaration dated 7/8/2024, that they have applied to PCI to increase the seat capacity from 60 to 100 for the academic session 2024-25; though BPT could not submit any no objection or permission letter from the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Tripura.
